



MIRROR CARE & CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Following the proper cleaning procedures will help ensure that your Electric Mirror continues to look beautiful throughout its lifespan.

Failure to follow these procedures may result in damage to the mirror and could void your warranty.



The best and safest way to clean your mirror is using clean, warm water and a microfiber cleaning cloth.



The following are the recommendations for the proper care and cleaning of your Electric Mirror:

Use the correct cleaner.

- The best and safest way to clean your mirror is using clean, warm water and a microfiber cleaning cloth.
- If you would like to use something other than warm water, the cleaner **must be Ammonia-Free**.
- **NEVER USE ACID OR ALKALI-BASED CLEANERS OR ANY CLEANERS CONTAINING AMMONIA OR VINEGAR.** Those substances will damage the mirror.
- In addition, no abrasive cleaners (scouring pads, bleach, baking soda, etc.) should ever be used on any mirror surface.

Use the correct cloth.

- Always use soft, grit-free and lint-free cloths to reduce the chance of scratching the mirror surface. The best choice is a clean, microfiber cloth.

Use the correct cleaning method.

- Never spray the water or cleaner directly onto the mirror. Instead, apply it to the cloth and then wipe the mirror. Be sure to remove any excess water/cleaner from the cloth before wiping the mirror.
- Do not allow the edges of the mirror to get or remain wet. Be sure to dry all joints and edges thoroughly to be certain no water or cleaner remains in contact with the edges or back surface of the mirror.

Additional cleaning instructions.

- Always use a new, clean cloth for each mirror. Do not clean multiple mirrors with the same cloth.
- When cleaning a multi-fixture mirror, always wipe in a direction away from the joints or seams. This helps prevent moisture or debris from collecting in hard-to-reach edges, making it easier to keep clean and dry.
